I invite you to consider these challenging and empowering words from New Testament Scholar Tom Wright: *If it is really true that in going to his death he took it upon himself and*



We decided that we do not all need to read the same book of poetry but that we each share one of her poems that we find meaningful. The next meeting is April 17 at 6:30 PM via Zoom.

According to Wikipedia, Ms. Sarton wrote 53 books, including 19 novels, 17 books of poetry, 15 nonfiction works, 2 children's books, a play, and additional screenplays. According to The Poetry Foundation, Sarton's style, as defined by critics, is calm, cultured, and urbane. In much of her writing, Sarton maintains a politically conscious lens. Several of her books and ebooks of poetry are available through the library system.

The book selected for May is *Hour of the Witch* by Chris Bohjalian. It is an historical novel about a woman seeking a divorce in 1662 Boston. It has been described as a page-turner, nail-biting thriller.


